HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

Overview:

Our nationally recognised cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training course gives participants the basic skills and knowledge if they were required to maintain a person's life in an emergency situation until help arrived. Participants will receive hands on practical training by experience qualified trainers. We teach to the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines, so you can feel confident knowing your skills meet national standards. This course is suitable to all persons whether you are new to learning CPR or need to refresh your training.

This course covers:

- How to properly assess an emergency situation
- DRSABCD
- CPR techniques on adults and infants
- Using an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Assessing and moving injured casualties
- Legal responsibilities of a first aider
- Basic anatomy and physiology

Pre-requisites:

As an assessment requirement of the HLTAID009 unit, participants must be able to perform at least 2 minutes (5 cycles) of CPR on an adult resuscitation manikin that is placed on the floor.

Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

It is recommended by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) that HLTAID009 is completed every 12 months to remain current with the ARC guidelines.

Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment with the following unit: HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

Delivery method:

2 hours classroom (This unit is recommended to be renewed every 12 months)

Fees and charges:

Fees include all assessments and resources required in the classroom. Students should wear appropriate clothing to kneel and bend in to complete the practical.
