



Annual Weapons Renewal (Queensland)

Overview:

This course is for those who currently hold a Security Guard Weapons Licence. A requirement of this licence is to complete recertification training every 12 months to renew the licence and remain current with skills and industry requirements. This course covers all the skills and knowledge required to use a firearm in the security industry.

Pre-requisites:

Participants are required to hold a current Queensland Weapons Licence (Security Licence Guard – Employee).

Participants must have sufficient skills to read, write and communicate in English, and have access to a computer with internet access and Microsoft Word. Mobile phones and tablets cannot be used to complete the online training component of this course.

Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

All Weapon Licences are administered by [Queensland Police – Weapons Licencing](#). Additional yearly renewal fees do apply.

Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment with the following unit:
CPPSEC3114 Control security risk situations using firearms
