Asbestos General Awareness Training (AGAT)

Overview:

This course aims to educate workers of the danger posed by Asbestos Containing Materials (ACM). Employers are required to provide awareness training to employees that work in environments where asbestos is present. The successful completion of this course ensures that learners are educated on the specific hazards and controls when working in workplaces containing asbestos containing materials.

Pre-requisites:

There are no pre-requisite units required to enrol into this course under the training package, however participants must have basic computer skills and access to a reliable computer with internet and e-mail access.

Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

This is a non-accredited course; however, this is a requirement under the Health and Safety act.

Topics:

- Identifying relevant OHS/WHS legislation that applies to asbestos
- Explaining what asbestos is and where it has commonly been used
- Identifying likely asbestos containing material
- Knowing health effects of exposure to asbestos
- Identifying when a license is required when removing asbestos
- Describing the safety requirements of working with asbestos

On successful completion, participants will be issued with a statement of completion.
