



CPPSS00059 Batons and Handcuffs Skill Set (Queensland)

Overview:

This course is for participants whose employer requires them to carry batons and handcuffs whilst performing their security duties – those who carry batons or handcuffs must complete the required training and be authorised by their employer to carry and have a genuine reason to carry and use. Our experienced trainer covers the legalities and the skills and knowledge required to present and control a person using batons and handcuffs. Participants will gain practical experience using batons and handcuffs in a simulated environment.

Pre-requisites:

Participants must have sufficient skills to read, write and communicate in English. They must hold a current Queensland Security Licence or completed a Certificate II in Security Operations.

Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

This course is not a licenced course. However, industry recommendation is to complete refresher training every 2 years to maintain current with skills and industry knowledge.

Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a statement of attainment with the following units:

CPPSEC3111 Restrain persons using handcuffs
