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CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (White Card)

Overview:

This nationally accredited unit of competency specifies the outcomes required to undertake Work Health and Safety (WHS) induction training within the construction industry. It requires the ability to demonstrate personal awareness of WHS legislative requirements, and the basic principles of risk management and prevention of injury and illness in the construction industry. This course is commonly known as White Card training or formally Blue Card training.

Queensland White Card Course - Special criteria applies - Any learner enrolling in a QLD online course must be a Queensland resident. You also must be located at least 100km away from the nearest registered training organisation offering face-to-face delivery.

Western Australia White Card Course – Anyone can enrol in the WA white card course, and will be issued with a WA white card which is recognised in all states.

Pre-requisites:

There are no pre-requisite units required to enrol into this course under the training package, however participants must have basic computer skills and access to a reliable computer with internet and e-mail access. Learners enrolling in a QLD online course must be a Queensland resident and must be located at least 100km away from the nearest registered training organisation offering face-to-face delivery.

Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

Licensing requirements will apply to this unit of competency depending on the regulatory requirements of each jurisdiction.

Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a statement of attainment with the following unit:
CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry

Participants will also receive a wallet sized white card.

Delivery method:

Online / self-paced with 3 months to complete (approximately 4-6 hours depending on the individual learner and their personal circumstances and other commitments). This training involves reading, activities and exams. Learners are also required to complete a verbal assessment, and demonstrate putting on and taking off PPE, either via skype, FaceTime or in person at our office in Sandgate. You must book in a time when we have a trainer available, and you must supply your own PPE if you are doing your demonstration via skype or FaceTime. For the QLD course- all exams must be performed in real time via audio and visual media with the assessor. Learners are also required to demonstrate putting on and taking off PPE during the video.
