



## Confined Space Entry with Gas Testing and Permit Issuer

### Overview:

This nationally recognised training course is suitable for participants who will be working in or around confined spaces, issuing work permits and needing to operate gas detectors in the resources and infrastructure industries.

Participants will gain the knowledge and skills to identify risks, review risk assessments and enter confined spaces in accordance with an issued work permit as well as issuing work permits to conduct work under the relevant legislation and Australian Standards for confined spaces. Participants will complete practical training in a simulated environment using the appropriate PPE and equipment.

**Pre-requisites:** Not applicable

### Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

It is industry recommendation that participants who obtain this competency complete recertification training every 2 years

### Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a statement of attainment with the following units:

- RIIWH202E Enter and work in confined space
- MSMPER205 Enter confined space
- MSMPER200 Work in accordance with an issued permit
- MSMPER202 Observe permit work
- RIIRIS201E Conduct local risk control
- MSMWHS217 Gas test atmospheres
- MSMWHS201 Conduct hazard analysis
- MSMPER300 Issue work permits
- MSMPER201 Monitor and control work permits

### Delivery method:

This course is run as a blend of online/self-paced learning and face-to-face training.

### Pre-course work:

Online/self-paced training (approximately 6-8 hours depending on the individual student and their personal circumstances and other commitments) this training involves reading learner guides and using this knowledge to complete exams. Online training **must** be completed prior to the face-to-face training.

### Face-to-face work:

4 hours face-to-face (approximately) your trainer will deliver practical training. Students have 6 months from the date of enrolment to complete the online training portion of the course. Support for the online portion of this course is done via email with an assessor.

**Group bookings** - blended delivery or 2 days face-to-face.

### Fees and charges:

Fees include all assessments and resources required in the classroom (and for pre-course online training). Students must provide their own closed in footwear and wear appropriate clothing.
