Overview:

This nationally recognised training program provides participants with the units of competency required to achieve a Statement of Attainment which forms part of RII30109 Certificate III in Surface Extraction Operations or RII30209. Upon successful completion of this training program, participants will have acquired the skills and knowledge to enable them to undertake the role of and perform the duties and position requirements of a Mine Safety and Health Representative. Students who enrol into this course must have a minimum of 3 months current onsite work experience in the Mining Industry or hold a current Standard 11 (Mining Induction) Statement of Attainment.

Pre-requisites:

Participants must hold and show evidence of:

A minimum of 3 months' current onsite work experience

or

Hold a current Standard 11 (QLD Mining Induction) Statement of Attainment

Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

It is an industry requirement that participants who obtain these competencies complete recertification training every 5 years.

Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a statement of attainment with the following units:

RIIRIS301D Apply Risk Management Processes (G1)

RIIWHS301D Conduct Safety and Health Investigations (G8)

RIICOM301D Communicate Information (G9)
