



HLTAID003 Provide First Aid

Overview:

Provide First Aid course (previously known as Senior First Aid/Level 2 Apply First Aid) is the minimum requirement under the Workplace Health and Safety Legislation for a workplace first aider. However, all persons are encouraged to complete a Provide First Aid course, regardless of their work requirements as it could help you save a life! Provide First Aid gives you the basic skills and knowledge to assist in any emergency situation until further help arrives. You will be trained by qualified trainers and partake in practical training to learn what to do for different emergencies.

Pre-requisites:

There are no pre-requisite units required to enrol into this course under the training package, however participants must have basic computer skills and access to a reliable computer with internet and e-mail access. Participants must be able to bend and kneel on the floor to perform CPR for at least 2 minutes.

Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

It is recommended by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) that HLTAID001 Provide CPR is completed every 12 months to remain current with the ARC guidelines and every 3 years for HLTAID003 Provide First Aid.

Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment with the following units:

HLTAID001 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

HLTAID002 Provide Basic Emergency Life Support

HLTAID003 Provide First Aid

Delivery method:

Option 1:

Pre-course work:

Online/self-paced training (approximately 3-5 hours depending on the individual learner and their personal circumstances and other commitments) this training involves reading, activities and exams. Online training **must** be completed prior to the face to face training.

Face-to-face work:

3.5 hours face-to-face (approximately) your trainer will deliver practical training.

Option 2: Group bookings only- blended delivery or 1 day face-to-face.

Fees and charges:

Fees include all assessments and resources required in the classroom- learners should wear appropriate clothing to kneel and bend in.
