



HLTAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

Overview:

This course gives participants the basic skills and knowledge if they were required to maintain a person's life in an emergency situation until help arrives. Participants will receive hands on practical training by experience qualified trainers. We teach to the Australian Resuscitation Council Guidelines, so you can feel confident knowing your skills meet national standards. This course is suitable to all persons whether you are new to learning CPR or need to refresh your training.

This course covers:

- How to properly assess an emergency situation
- DRSABCD
- CPR techniques on adults and infants
- Using an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Assessing and moving injured casualties
- Legal responsibilities of a first aider
- Basic anatomy and physiology
- And much, much more!

Pre-requisites:

There are no pre-requisite units required to enrol into this course under the training package, however participants must be able to bend and kneel on the floor to perform CPR for at least 2 minutes.

Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

It is recommended by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) that HLTAID009 is completed every 12 months to remain current with the ARC guidelines.

Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment with the following units:

Delivery method:

2 hours classroom (This unit is recommended to be renewed every 12 months)

Fees and charges:

Fees include all assessments and resources required in the classroom. Students should wear appropriate clothing to kneel and bend in.
