HLTAID012 Provide an emergency first aid response in education and care setting

Overview:

This course gives participants the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to infants, children, and adults. It is most suited to educators and support staff working within an education and care setting who are required to respond to a first aid emergency, including asthmatic and anaphylactic emergencies. This course would also benefit sporting organisations or local community groups who do work with young children. Participants will receive practical hands-on training with a qualified trainer, to enable them to provide emergency assistance to young children until further help arrives.

Pre-requisites:

Participants must have basic computer skills and access to a reliable computer with internet and email access. Mobile phones or tablets are not compatible with the online training portion of this course. As an assessment requirement of the HLTAID009 unit, participants must be able to perform at least 2 minutes (5 cycles) of CPR on an adult, child and baby resuscitation manikin that is placed on the floor.

Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

It is recommended by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) that HLTAID009 Provide CPR is completed every 12 months to remain current with the ARC guidelines and every 3 years for HLTAID012 Provide an emergency First Aid response in an education and care setting.

Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment with the following units:

HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation HLTAID010 Provide basic emergency life support HLTAID011 Provide First Aid HLTAID012 Provide First Aid in an education and care setting

Delivery method:

Option 1:

Pre-course work:

Online/self-paced training (approximately 3-6 hours depending on the individual student and their personal circumstances and other commitments). This online training involves reading interactive modules and then using this information to complete exams. Online training **must** be completed prior to the face-to-face training.

Face-to-face work:

4 hours face-to-face (approximately) your trainer will deliver practical training. **Option 2:** Group bookings - blended delivery or 1 day face-to-face.

Fees and charges:

Fees include all assessments and resources required in the classroom and for pre-course online training. Students should wear appropriate clothing to kneel and bend in to complete the practical.
