



Occupational First Aid

Overview:

This course gives participants the skills and knowledge required to provide first aid response in complex incidents/emergencies where an Ambulance may be some time away and how to establish and manage the workplace first aid room. Participants will learn how to utilise specialised first aid equipment; stabilise a casualty where medical aid has been delayed; maintain life in an unconscious casualty with the use of oxygen equipment; and operate a defibrillator unit in order to maintain life in an adult casualty in cardiac arrest.

Pre-requisites:

There are no pre-requisite units required to enrol into this course under the training package, however participants must have basic computer skills and access to a reliable computer with internet and e-mail access. Participants must be able to bend and kneel on the floor to perform CPR for at least 2 minutes.

Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

It is recommended by industry councils and legislations that this course is renewed every 3 years (HLTAID002 & HLTAID007 every 12 months) to remain up to date with the latest guidelines.

Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment with the following units:

- HLTAID001 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation
- HLTAID002 Provide Basic Emergency Life Support
- HLTAID003 Provide First Aid
- HLTAID006 Provide Advanced First Aid
- HLTAID007 Provide Advanced Resuscitation
- HLTAID008 Manage First Aid Services and Resources

Delivery method:

Pre-course work:

Online/self-paced training (approximately 3-5 hours depending on the individual learner and their personal circumstances and other commitments) this training involves reading, activities and exams. Online training **must** be completed prior to the face to face training.

Face-to-face work:

2 days face-to-face- your trainer will deliver practical training.

Fees and charges:

Fees include all assessments and resources required in the classroom.
