RIIRIS402D Carry out the risk management process (G2)

Overview:

The RIIRIS402A Carry out the risk management process unit of competency covers the skills and knowledge required to carry out risk management processes in the Resources and Infrastructure Industries. This course is often a requirement for mine workers who are wishing to progress their career into a position of leading hand, supervisor, superintendent, deputy or those who are elected as a Site Safety and Health Representative.

Pre-requisites:

There are no pre-requisites under the training package, however due to industry requirements participants must supply a Statement of Attainment with unit of competency RIIRIS301D - Apply risk management processes. This is a unit from the Mining Supervisor (G1,G8,G9) and the Statement of Attainment must be issued less than 5 years ago.

Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

It is industry recommendation that participants who obtain these competencies complete recertification training every 5 years to maintain current and up to date with industry standards.

Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will gain a statement of attainment with the following unit:
RIIRIS402D Carry out the risk management processes

Delivery method:
