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## Work Safely at Heights

### Overview:

This Nationally Accredited training course will give participants the skills and knowledge required to work safely on construction sites where the work activity involves working above 2 metres from ground level and where fall protection measures are required. Participants will put their knowledge and skills to the test in a simulated environment with access to a roof to complete the practical assessment.

This course benefits those interested in gaining employment in the resources, construction or infrastructure industries. To remain current and updated with the industry it is recommended that participants complete this course every 2 years.

### Pre-requisites:

There are no pre requisities under the training package, however participants must have basic computer skills and access to a reliable computer with internet and e-mail access. Participants must also be physically fit and able to do practical demonstrations on a simulated rooftop.

#### Option 1:

##### Pre-course work:

2 hours face-to-face (approximately) your trainer will deliver practical training.
