HLTAID013 Provide First Aid in remote or isolated site

Overview:

This remote first aid course is specifically designed to meet the first aid needs of bushwalkers, wilderness guides, and people who work or live in remote locations. The course covers everything from comprehensive first aid treatments to aeromedical evacuation, long-term care, self-care and contingency planning. This course is focused on the safety of the first aider and extended care of an ill or injured casualty where help is likely to be delayed or inaccessible.

Pre-requisites:

Participants must have basic computer skills and access to a reliable computer with internet and email access. Mobile phones or tablets are not compatible with the online training portion of this course. As an assessment requirement of the HLTAID009 unit, participants must be able to perform at least 2 minutes (5 cycles) of CPR on an adult resuscitation manikin that is placed on the floor.

Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

It is recommended by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) that HLTAID009 Provide CPR is completed every 12 months to remain current with the ARC guidelines and every 3 years for HLTAID013 Provide First Aid in remote or isolated site.

Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment with the following units:

HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

HLTAID010 Provide basic emergency life support

HLTAID011 Provide First Aid

HLTAID013 Provide First Aid in remote or isolated site

Delivery method:

Option 1 (Blended):

Pre-course work:

Online/self-paced training (approximately 4-5 hours depending on the individual student and their personal circumstances and other commitments). This online training involves reading interactive modules and then using the knowledge learnt to complete a final exam. Online training **must** be completed prior to the face-to-face training.

Face-to-face work:

1 day face-to-face, your trainer will deliver practical training.

Option 2: Group bookings - blended delivery or 2 days face-to-face.

Fees and charges:

Fees include all assessments and resources required in the classroom (and for pre-course online training). Students should wear appropriate clothing to kneel and bend in to complete the practical.
