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Dual Certificate III in Security and Close Protection Operations (Queensland)

Overview:

This qualification is suitable for individuals who already hold a Queensland Security Licence and wish to deepen and broaden their skills and knowledge in security operations and lead security teams in the field. It provides a pathway to further learning and work in various security roles and settings, including security risk management. Security officers at this level provide leadership in a team environment, operate under limited supervision, and use discretion and judgement in known and unpredictable work contexts. This course is also for participants wishing to apply for a Queensland Bodyguard Licence.

Pre-requisites:

Participants must hold a current Queensland Security Licence. Participants must have sufficient skills to read, write and communicate in English, and have access to a computer with email and internet access, and Microsoft Word. Mobile phones and tablets cannot be used to complete the online training component of this course. Participants must also be physically fit, and able to perform defensive tactic techniques. As an assessment requirement of the HLTAID014 unit, participants must be able to perform at least 2 minutes (5 cycles) of CPR on an adult resuscitation manikin that is placed on the floor.

Licence & Regulatory Requirements (Bodyguard component ONLY - Class 1):

All Queensland Security Licences are administered by Office of Fair Trading. All participants are encouraged to read through the requirements of a Queensland Security Licence application, as there is additional requirements & fees payable to Office of Fair Trading. For example, participants must be over the age of 18, must be a fit and proper person, cannot have had any disqualifying offences under the criminal code in the last 10 years.

On successful completion participants will be issued with two qualifications with the following units:

This course is run as a blend of online/self-paced learning and face-to-face training. Online training + 3 days classroom.

The online training is approximately 15-20 hours per unit (for a total of 15 units), however this greatly depends on the individual and their experience. Online/self-paced training – this involves reading a student manual and completing written, case scenario and online practical assessments (using Microsoft Word). Online training must be completed prior to booking in for the face-toface training. Students have 12 months to complete this course from the date of enrolment.

Support for this online training is done via email with an assessor.
