



CPCWHS2001 Apply WHS requirements, policies and procedures in the construction industry

Overview:

This nationally recognised unit specifies the outcomes required to carry out work health and safety (WHS) requirements through safe work practices in all on or off-site construction workplaces. It requires the performance of work in a safe manner through awareness of risks and work requirements, and the planning and performance of safe work practices with concern for personal safety and the safety of others.

Assessors for the unit of competency CPCWHS1001 (formally CPCWHS1001) Prepare to work safely in the construction industry ('White card' assessors) must hold the CPCWHS2001 unit of competency to be able to assess students. This unit is also relevant for professional development for those in the construction industry.

Pre-requisites:

Participants must have basic computer skills and access to a reliable computer with internet, email access and access to Microsoft Word. Mobile phones and tablets cannot be used to complete this online course.

Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment with the following unit: CPCWHS2001 Apply WHS requirements, policies and procedures in the construction industry

Delivery method:

Online/self-paced, the student has 3 months to complete from enrolment. The typical duration of this course is between 3.5-5 hours (based on experience). Support for this online training is done via email with an assessor.

You can start your online training as soon as you complete payment for the course. You will have access to all your learning resources and assessments via your online portal and can complete the course at your own pace, so you have the opportunity to accelerate your learning and finish this course as quickly as you like!
