



## HLTAID011 Provide First Aid (including CPR), with UETDRRF004 Perform Rescue from a Live LV Panel (LVR)

### Overview:

This course combines the Provide First Aid and LVR course. Provide First Aid (previously known as Senior First Aid/Level 2 Apply First Aid) is the minimum requirement under the Workplace Health and Safety Legislation for a workplace first aider. However, all persons are encouraged to complete a Provide First Aid course, regardless of their work requirements, as it could help you save a life! Provide First Aid gives you the basic skills and knowledge to assist in any emergency situation until further help arrives. You will be trained by qualified trainers and partake in practical training to learn what to do for different emergencies. This course includes CPR training (HLTAID009).

This course also covers the performance of rescue procedures from live Low Voltage (LV) apparatus, not including overhead lines and underground cables in the workplace. It specifies the mandatory requirements of rescue from a live LV panel and how they apply in the context of transmission, distribution or rail work functions. It encompasses responsibilities for health, safety and risk management processes at all operative levels and adherence to safety practices as part of the normal way of doing work.

### Pre-requisites:

Participants must have basic computer skills and access to a reliable computer with internet and email access. Mobile phones or tablets are not compatible with the online training portion of this course. As an assessment requirement of the HLTAID009 unit, participants must be able to perform at least 2 minutes (5 cycles) of CPR on an adult resuscitation manikin that is placed on the floor.

### Licence & Regulatory Requirements:

It is recommended by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) that HLTAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and UETDRRF004 Perform rescue from a live LV panel is completed every 12 months to remain current with the ARC guidelines and HLTAID011 Provide First Aid needs to be completed every 3 years.

### Units of Competency:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment with the following units:

- HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- HLTAID010 Provide basic emergency life support
- HLTAID011 Provide First Aid
- UETDRRF004 Perform rescue from a live LV panel

### Delivery method:

#### Option 1 (Blended):

#### Pre-course work:

Online/self-paced training (approximately 3-5 hours depending on the individual student and their personal circumstances and other commitments). This online training involves reading interactive modules and then using this information to complete a final exam. Online training **must** be completed prior to the face-to-face training.

#### Face-to-face work:

4 hours face-to-face (approximately) your trainer will deliver practical training.

**Option 2:** Group bookings - blended delivery or 1 day face-to-face.
