



Fire Awareness and Fire Extinguisher Training (non-accredited)

Overview:

This workplace first response fire training course will ensure that all your employees are suitably trained in the safe use of fire extinguishers, fire hose reels and fire blankets. Whilst this course focuses on fire safety awareness in the workplace, the principles learnt in this course can also be applied to fire safety in the student's home.

This course will provide students with an understanding of:

- The basic characteristics of fire, and the risk to life and property it poses.
- How to respond to a fire emergency.
- How to use fire-fighting equipment such as:
 - Fire extinguishers
 - Fire blankets
 - Fire hose reels
- First aid treatment for heat burns.
- Post-incident procedures, such as debriefing and reporting requirements.

It is recommended that training is conducted every 2 years to stay refreshed.

Pre-requisites:

Participants must have basic computer skills and access to a reliable computer with internet and email access.

Units of Competency:

This course is a non-accredited course.

Upon completion of the training, participants will receive a certificate of completion for their fire awareness and fire extinguisher training.

Delivery method:

This course is estimated to take 60 minutes. Students have 3 months from the date of enrolment to complete.
