BACKGROUND

This audit is being conducted as part of the Strategic Industry Review into training for the Security industry, under the authority of Section 35 (2) of the *National Vocational Education & Training Regulator Act 2011.* ASQA is conducting a number of these audits across Australia.

This Review is being conducted because of concerns raised about the quality of the training and assessment provided by some Registered Training Organisations (RTOs), by coroners, regulators,

employers and the industry generally

The findings of the Strategic Industry Review will be published. No names of RTOs will be included in the Review report.

The Australian Training Institute (ATI) Pty Ltd (trading as Australian Training Institute) is an Australian Proprietary Company, Limited By Shares and was first registered with ASIC, in its current form, on 17/02/2011. The company delivers training and assessment from the Business Services, Community Services, Property Services (security), and Tourism, Travel and Hospitality (hospitality) training packages. Its scope of registration includes 15 qualifications, 59 units of competency, and three accredited courses. Initial registration as an RTO is listed as 1998.

The CEO of the RTO is Jason Naylor. Supporting the CEO are five part time administration staff (positions are Receptionist, Co Provider Officer, Administration Officer, Accounts Officer, and Project and Compliance Officer). The CEO is responsible for overall RTO compliance and management (including the delivery of training and assessment), with each supporting officer having duties relating to their position.

The main business activities conducted by the RTO are security training and assessment (approx. 50% of business), short courses in mining (20%) and other programs from its scope (20%). The CEO operates a separate safety and security consultancy 'International Risk Management'.

The primary clients of the NRT business activities are existing workers seeking to enter the industry (no security experience), and jobseekers (may be from disadvantaged backgrounds).

The RTO's NRT revenue is derived from fee for service activities (40%) and the QLD Government Certificate III Guarantee (60%). The RTO has established approximately 8 'co provider' subcontracting arrangements with trainers and assessors.

The delivery mode of the security NRT is face to face class room based, including some out of session self-directed learning. The RTO delivers security training in QLD (Sandgate), SA (Port Lincoln), WA (Perth), and is preparing for delivery in NSW.

The RTO's primary marketing activities include website, social media (Facebook, Gumtree), newspaper advertisements, and word of mouth referrals.

- meet training package requirements. The RTO is delivering a total of 16 units of competency packaged within the CPP20212 Certificate II in Security Operations. The qualification framework of the qualification requires that a total of 12 units are delivered to achieve the qualification.
- identify how assessment processes will assess the practical application of the requirements of any given unit, but specifically for the unit CPPSEC2004B Respond to security risk situations.

CPP30411 Certificate III in Security Operations

The strategy for the above listed qualification does not:

 identify how assessment processes will assess the practical application of the requirements of any given unit, but specifically for the units CPPSEC3002A Manage conflict through negotiation and CPPSEC3007A Maintain security of environment.

- the Statement of Attainment does not include the words "A Statement of Attainment is issued by a Registered Training Organisation when an individual has completed one or more accredited units"
- the RTO is issuing a full qualification listing numbers of units in excess of the CPP Property Services Training Package qualification structure requirements, rather than a qualification and a Statement of Attainment listing the additional units.

 provide evidence that its VET Qualifications and Statements of Attainment meets the Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) Requirements for the CPP20212 Certificate II in Security Operations qualification and any Statement of Attainment it may issue for additional units delivered to meet licensing outcomes.
